**PRESS NOTE**

**Date: 21/02/2026**

In compliance to the Election Commission of India instructions No. 23/2025/ERS (Vol.II) dated 27/10/2025, No. 23/2025-ERS (Vol.II) dated 30/11/2025 and No. 23/GOA/2026/WS-II dated 11/02/2026, the Special Intensive Revision 2026 with qualifying date 01/01/2026 has been conducted in Goa.

The details of the total number of electors before Draft publication i.e. as on 27/10/2025 was as under:

The Enumeration Forms (EFs) were generated & printed for all the above **11,85,034** electors and distributed through the BLOs of the state, out of which 10,84,992 (**91.56%**) Enumeration Forms were received back from the electors. Total 1,00,042 (**8.44 %**) Enumeration Forms were not received back from the electors due to the reasons as mentioned below and these persons were listed as ASDDs (Absentee, Shifted, Dead & Duplicate), the detailed breakup of the same is as follows:

The Draft Roll was published on 16/12/2025 accordingly with **10,84,992** total number of electors. The breakup of which is as under:

Out of the total **10,84,992** electors in the Draft Roll, 9,02,589 electors (83.19% of 10,84,992 Draft Roll) were mapped with their own/parents' electoral details of the Last SIR held at their place of ordinary residence. Whereas, **1,82,403 electors** (16.81% of 10,84,992 Draft Roll) in the Draft Roll were unmapped. The details of the mapping are as under:

Out of these **9,02,589** mapped electors, **58,923** number of electors were listed as Logical Discrepancies (LD) by the ECI IT System due to discrepancies in mapping identified under various categories in the ECINET, the details of which are as follows:

Decisions were taken by the EROs/ AEROs with respect to these above cases of Logical Discrepancies and Unmapped electors after issuing Notices and conducting hearings/ collecting documents/ BLO Undertakings as per the provisions made available in the ECINET by the ECI IT team from time to time.

Apart from above, a total number of 24,949 claims and objections filed to the Draft Roll (16/12/2025 to 19/01/2026) in Forms (6/7/8/6A) which were processed for the final roll. In addition to above, there were pending forms 6, 7, 8, 6A which were received prior to 16/12/2025.

Out of all of the above forms, total **12,166** electors were added and **3,812** electors were deleted.

Further, 35780 electors were marked as ineligible after deciding cases under category unmapped and Logical Discrepancies.

The total electors displaying now on the Final Roll published on 21/02/2026 is as under:

The total number of electors as per the draft roll published on 16/12/2025 with reference to 01/01/2026 as qualifying was **10,84,992**. Whereas, after the Special Intensive Revision 2026 with qualifying date 01/01/2026, in the final roll which is published on 21/02/2026, the total number of electors are **10,57,566**. The total form 6 admitted during Special Intensive Revision are **12166** and the total voters deleted are **39592**. Net change since previous roll is **27426** which is **-2.53%** change over previous roll.

There is 100% photo coverage along with 100% EPIC coverage for general electors. Total overseas electors enrolled as on date is 22.

The percentage of 18-19 years age electors is 3.41% as per the projected population, 0.57% in the draft publication dated 16/12/2025, which has increased to 0.89% in the final roll which is published on 21/02/2026.

The gender ratio of the State as per 2026 projected population is 1063. As per the draft roll published on 16/12/2025, the gender ratio of the State was 1073. In the final roll, the gender ratio is now 1068.

The total number of Polling Stations after rationalization are 1731.

The Final Electoral Roll of SIR 2026 is displayed at all polling stations on 21.02.2026. Further, the Final Roll will be available for public inspection in the offices of the Electoral Registration Officers and of the Assistant Electoral Registration Officers from 21.02.2026. Further, copy of the final Electoral Roll of Special Intensive Revision, 2026 shall be provided to the recognised political parties. Furthermore, in case any person is aggrieved with the decision of the Electoral Registration Officer, then he/she may file a first appeal before the District Magistrate within 15 days of the decision of the Electoral Registration Officer under Section 24(a) of the RP Act, 1950, read with rule 27 of the RER, 1960 and second appeal before the Chief Electoral Officer within 30 days of the decision of the District Magistrate under Section 24(b) of the RP Act, 1950, read with rule 27 of the RER, 1960.

The final Electoral Roll of Special Summary Revision of last part of electoral rolls relating to Service voters with reference to 01.01.2026 as the qualifying date is also published on 21/02/2026 and there are 301 Service electors as per the final roll.
